NOTES:

-  The Amazon River is the main river for excursions into the jungle, especially during low ebb, which occurs between June and November.
-  Low ebb on the Napo River occurs between September and February.
-  In the Peruvian Amazon Area, there are only 3 months of high water level (March – May).
-  For sports fishing you will need a medium action open or closed rod and reel, ultra resistance fishing line, snap swivels, and bait, top waters, rattling, lures, etc.
